GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS RESOURCES

In this text, "you" is to be interpreted as the client who has made the booking and all participants the client is bringing with him in his group. Participation in a Trek Ski Plus event is understood as acceptance by the participant of those General Terms and Conditions.

1 - Physical prerequisites: an appropriate physical condition is required for all trips.

Please consider the suitability of such an event/activity before booking. It is the responsibility of the client to be aware of the fitness level for a particular trip. When in doubt, please call and discuss it with a Trek Ski Plus staff member.

The client must inform Trek Ski Plus before the start of a tour of medical conditions, illnesses or disorders that may be relevant for safety reasons or aggravated during the tour.

Participants under age 18 must present to Trek Ski Plus a written letter from their legal guardian granting permission to participate in the event.

2 - Equipment: every participant is required to bring the equipment listed by the guide.

The guide will ensure that all participants have all the necessary equipment or clothing and reserve the right to exclude participants who don't have the minimum equipment required.

The customer is responsible for all equipment issued for use during the tour. The guide reserves the right to demand payment or replacement for equipment that is lost or misused.

3 - Liability: Trek Ski Plus tries to lead tours as safe as possible and conform to all possible situations during the tour. Nevertheless, all participants must have a liability waiver on file before participating on a Trek Ski Plus tour

5 - Program change: Trek Ski Plus reserves the right to change the tour itinerary, should the leader believe that continuing would place any group member and/or himself at undue risk due to unfavorable weather conditions mountain conditions or participant ability.

For stopped or changed tours, the whole amount for the primary planned tour will be charged.

6 - No shows: you are responsible for arriving on time at the notified meeting point. All public hiking tours run on "Italian Time". This means that we leave promptly at the published departure time. If you are late, the tour may leave without you and your reservation will be forfeited without refund. Please make your greatest effort to show up on time.

7 - Transportation: [private transportation release consent/limitation of the liability of the driver when travelling in someone else's car]

You acknowledge that Trek Ski Plus is not responsible for providing transportation to and from the activity location and that you may have to make my own private arrangements for your transportation.

If you participate in car-pooling with other participants and/or the guide in the particular event, then you do so entirely at your own risk and without any right to claim against Trek Ski Plus for any loss, damages, or personal injury whatsoever you may suffer.

You agree to assume all of the risks and responsibilities associated with your transportation to and from the activity location.

8 - Group tours involve joining with other guests towards a common itinerary. These are fun & sociable trips and we try hard to ensure all members of the team are suited to the tours they are signed up for. However, occasionally guests will struggle from unforeseen circumstances and will have to turn around during a tour. By booking on one of the public tours you are joining a group and must accept this may compromise your own vacation goal or other agenda. Folk not wanting to accept this compromise should book private guiding.

9 - Booking:

1/ Call or e-mail Trek Ski Plus to inquire about tour availability. Once your reservation has been accepted, you will be asked to pay the initial deposit. Payments are accepted by Paypal

2/ Pay the tour fee. The booking is not finalized until the payment has been received! Once the payment is received, the cancellation policy is in effect and it is implied and accepted that you have read and understood all the booking information and conditions and agree to abide by them.

Trek Ski Plus is not responsible for any incidental expenses the client may have incurred in reliance on the tour including, without limitation, expenses arising from the purchase of visas, vaccinations, non-refundable flights, car rental or public transportation fees, or of any loss of enjoyment.

All prices quoted are subject to change without notice.

10 - Cancellation:

• Trek Ski Plus reserves the right to cancel any trip because of causes that make it infeasible for the scheduling of the trip (conditions on the mountain, illness, injury or insufficient number of participants). If this is the case, you will be informed within 24 hours prior to trip start date. In the event of this occurring, you will be offered an alternative or full refund of the trip costs. Trek Ski Plus takes no responsibility for any other fees that the client has incurred like flights, hotels or any other expenses relating to arriving at the tour starting point or extended reservations after the tour.

• By the client: if you wish to cancel your trip, this must be done by email or sms. The following conditions will apply, according to when you inform Trek Ski Plus:

** In the event of cancellation, the following will apply:

Days prior to departure Percentage of tour price

- From date of booking to 60 days prior departure loss of deposit.
- 60-41 days 25% of total price
- 40-26 days 50% of total price
- Within 25 days of departure Total tour price
